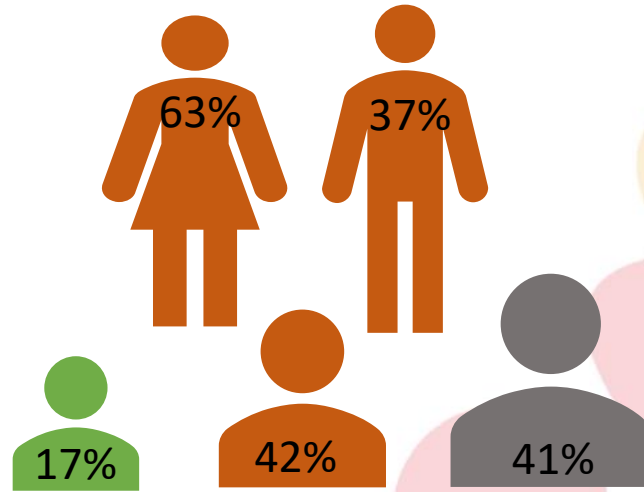

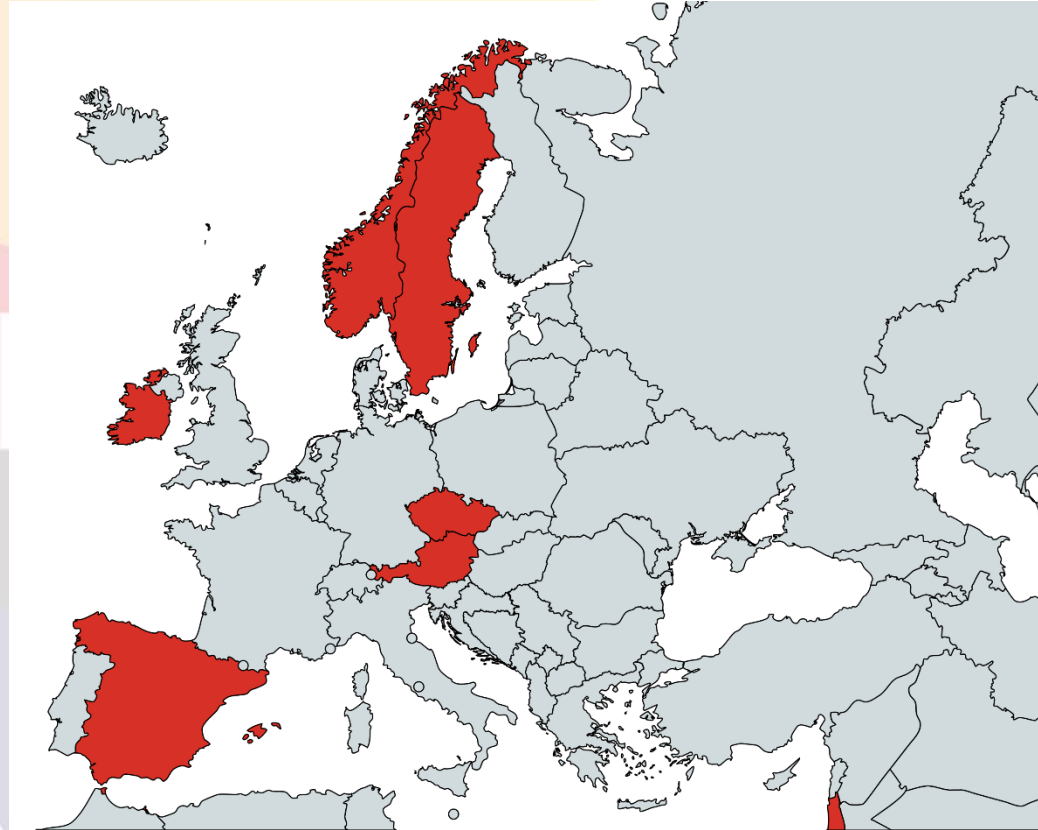

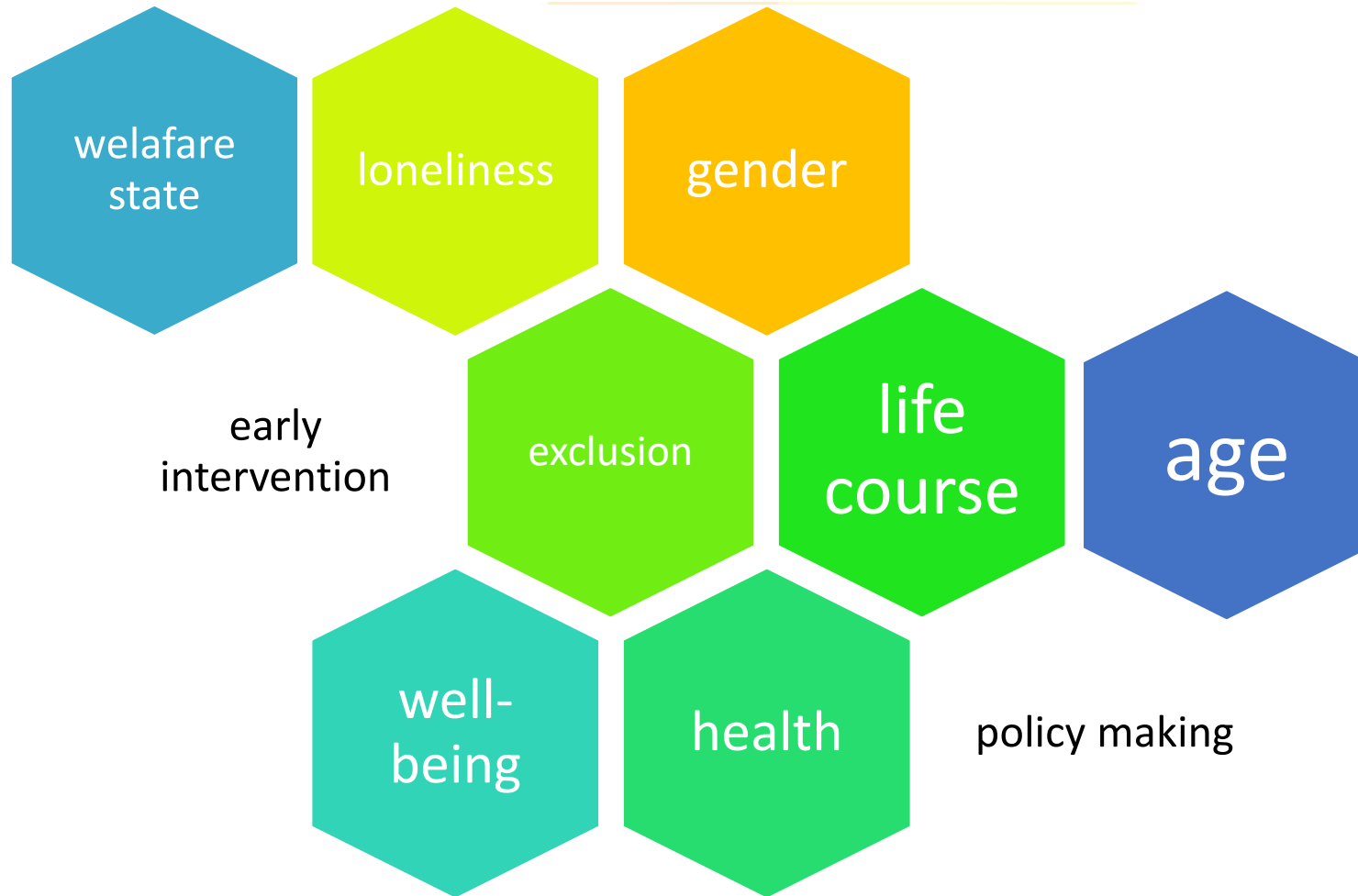
# The team : diversity, gender expertise and gender equality measures

# Objectives and expected results of the project



# Advancement of knowledge on gender studies

- Bringing AGE to gender studies
- Gender sensitive methodological tools & methodology testing (quanti & quali)
- Innovative definition of the ESR – more relevant to different (gendered) life trajectories and (gendered) living environments
- Pointing out an interplay of ageing & gender in various cultural backgrounds
  - Early socialization consequences will not necessarily lead to ESR at old age BUT for men we found a effect of physical aspects of childhood living conditions (e.g. overcrowding, physical harm experience, financial difficulties). For women, the cultural capital of family of origin and the quality of relations with parents seem to have a greater effect on small social network in older age
